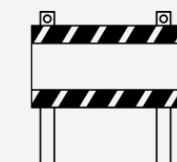
2025 Wool Festival Drink Booths

I am rounding down on my fall travels with the State 4-H judging team, but please remember I am always available to each of you- on the road or at home!

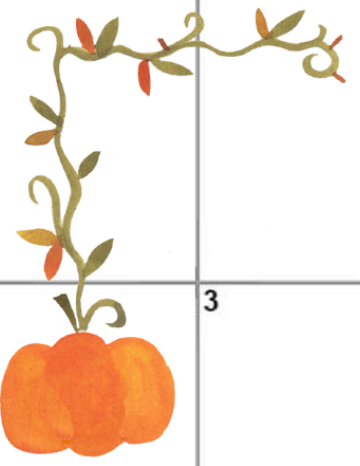
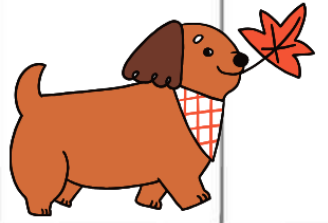
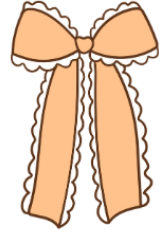


New Building News!

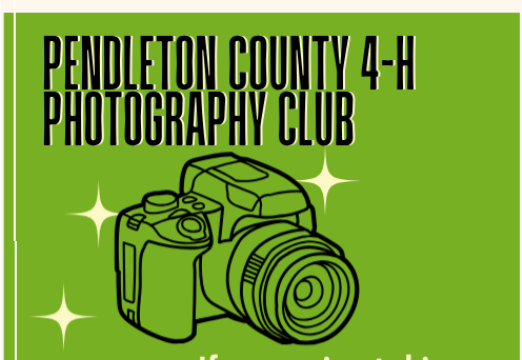

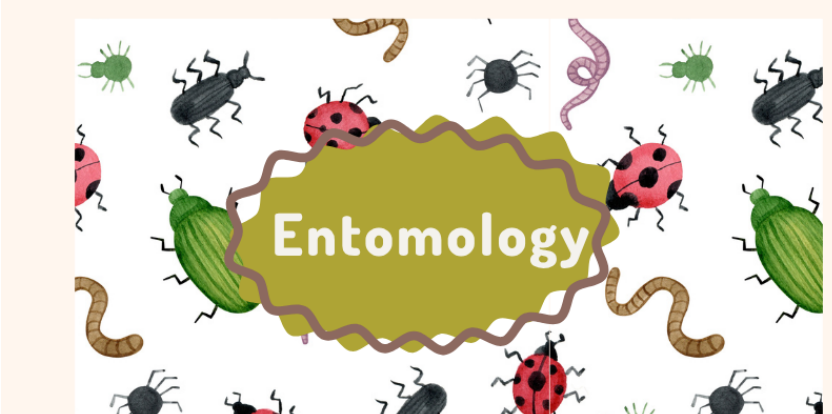
